IMPACT OF COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS ON THE COMPANY'S ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

Babylon Pump & Power Limited (ACN 009 436 908) (**Company**) is pleased to advise that it will hold its annual general meeting of shareholders at 8.30am (WST) on 15 December 2020 at the Swan View Room, Tompkins on Swan, Corner Dunkley Avenue and Canning Highway, Alfred Cove WA 6154 (**Meeting**).

Due to the easing of restrictions in Western Australia, the Board has made the decision that it will hold a physical Meeting with the appropriate social gathering and physical distancing measures in place to comply with the current Federal and State Government restrictions for physical gatherings.

In accordance with temporary modifications to the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth) under the Corporations (Coronavirus Economic Response) Determination (No 3) 2020, the Company will not be sending hard copies of the Notice of Meeting to Shareholders. Your proxy voting instruction must be received by no later 8.30am (WST) on 13 December 2020, being not less than 48 hours before the commencement of the Meeting. Any proxy voting instructions received after that time will not be valid for the Meeting.
